

Systems FAC Meeting  
25 May 2000

1. This “face to face” meeting took place during the CADD/GIS Technology Center Symposium 2000 at the Adam’s Mark Hotel in St. Louis, MO.
2. Joe Zullo and Gary Lambert of Intergraph were invited to give a brief talk on the status of Intergraph. They assured us that Intergraph Federal Systems has not disappeared, it has simply become Intergraph Government Solutions. It has the same personnel, same services, and the same government contracts. Compaq and HP hardware is being added to the Navy contracts.
3. The mdl conversion project is 80-90% done. John Kincaid is looking for a few good folks (or districts) to take another look at the list of targeted mdl’s to see if we can decrease the number down a bit. There are currently close to 80 that are being converted (or updated) and we know that some of them have been incorporated into Microstation already or are duplicates (or almost duplicates) of each other.
4. There are a lot of DA mandates coming down the pike these days having to do with IM and computer security. Some of them may directly affect how we do our CADD business. Also, the CEAP contract expires on 30 Sept. and the new Infrastructure Acquisition Support 2000 (IAS2K) takes its place. You can get more information on this at: <http://www.ceap.usace.army.mil>

Windows2000 cannot be loaded onto any servers until the army approves it. Also, don’t look to see it on any workstations for a year or so.
