1. There has been a proposal for the districts to combine some of their SELECT training/consulting credits in order to hire Bentley for consulting and training on Workspace Implementation. The type and breadth of the consulting/training needs to still be determined.

John Kincaid and Roger Porzig have been tasked to draft a letter to Engineering Division Chiefs explaining the credits and asking if they would be willing to participate in the workspace implementation proposal. John is going to try to get some general cost estimates from Bentley based on different sets of criteria. Districts would not be required to throw in all their credits, just a portion of them. Please let John Kincaid know if your district would be willing to participate in this plan.

2. John Kincaid will be sending out a URL pointing to the CADD Survey. Please take a look at the survey to see if it is adequate. Once he is satisfied that the survey looks good, he will send out unique logins and passwords to each district so that the survey can be completed. This will be a live database and can be updated and changed at any time (using the login and password).

3. Misc notes:

a. The Corps Knowledge Base web site is to be updated. John has a couple of people willing to help with that effort and he will be contacting them.

b. The Headquarters web page has information on CEERIS and EDMS for those who are interested.

c. Justin Taylor (HQ) has sent out a letter to Engineering Division Chiefs with the Subject Heading: Totally Integrated Project Delivery for Engineering Division. The memo is about a meeting being held this week in Washington on the Subject topic. The outcome of this meeting (and future meetings) could drastically effect the way we do business in Engineering Division and it is highly recommended that we get hold of a copy of the letter and understand what is being discussed.
