1. Workspace Training Letter: The letter for Engineering Division Chiefs is waiting on a Select Credits price quote from Bentley. Once that is received the letter will go out. The training breakdown is going to be:

5. Workspace - The beta release has finally been received by those on the list of beta testers. There was much discussion on some of the problems that the beta testers have come across, including but not limited to: network installation, scale button and options, & text boxes coming up out of nowhere. Savannah District pointed out that the Workspace does not seem to be compatible with Triforma. The Tri-Service center has a team in Savannah this week doing an evaluation of

Toby will try to schedule a meeting with Bentley in Atlanta on Friday, Jan. 29 to work out the fixes. Roger Porzig and John Kincaid will attend to represent the Systems FAC and the Corps of Engineers.
