

Systems Administrator Conference Call
November 16, 1999, 10:00 CST

1. Workspace User Manager Training – A discussion was held on the Workspace Manager Training. The general consensus was that the training went well and the Manuals are OK. Steve Hutsell (Ft. Worth) and John Kincaid (Rock Island) are compiling lists of comments and recommendations for the manuals to be forwarded on to Bentley/A+ CADD for incorporation. If you have any comments you would like to add, please e-mail them to John. No word yet on when the final release of the Workspace and Standards will happen.
2. Headquarters has given the SAC Group \$100,000 dollars for projects this year (FY2000). The SAC Group will be meeting in early December to discuss what to do with this money. John Kincaid and Debbi Solis (Jacksonville District) will also be attending the meeting. If you have a project that you would like to see done, write up a project proposal and e-mail it to John or Debbie and they will present it at the meeting.
3. John Kincaid is working on a Scope of Work to have a custom training class developed for and given to Rock Island District on using Triforma in a Standards Compatible Way. If you would like to see a copy of this Scope of Work and/or feel you could give him some good input on what to include, drop him an e-mail and he will send a copy out to you once it is done.
4. Debbie Solis announced that there is to be an Advance Inroads class sponsored by the Civil FAC to be held the last week of January in Jacksonville. The class is to be taught by Mike Cavanaugh of Intergraph. David Hammerich, the Civil FAC chair, will be sending out additional information on the class soon.

Lynn Riggs (St. Paul District) stated that his district is not pleased with the color/pen assignments in the Tri-Service standards and that they are working to get them changed and would like the support of this group.
